Charles Bean Sanctuary:

Members reviewed the deed to the sanctuary. Discussion ensued about proposed signage which will be placed along the road and along the shoreline both at the south-facing beach and the west-facing area near the sandbar. Bill presented his draft of proposed sign which reads,

Martha shared her initial draft, but agreed Bill's was more concise. She suggested the title to Bill's draft read: Charles Bean Conservation Area (title from deed), then say: Wildlife Sanctuary.

Members discussed pros and cons of wording on the sign and the addition of "No Trespassing" with a reference to the NH Criminal Trespass statute.

Martha will contact the Selectboard so that the Conservation Commission can meet with them to finalize the wording on the signs and get their approval. Members agreed that signs would be placed along the road and along the waterfront of the Bean Sanctuary.

There being no further business to discuss, Suzanne made a motion to adjourn. Bill seconded. All concurred. Meeting was adjourned 8 pm.
