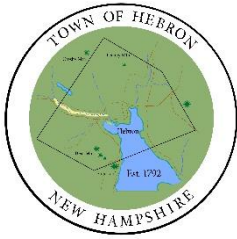

**Minutes of Meeting April 5, 2021**

Paul Hazelton, Select Board Representative called the meeting to order at 7:06 PM. Paul made a motion to nominate John Dunklee as Chairman. The motion was seconded by Curtis Mooney and the vote was in the affirmative with everyone voting in favor. John asked for a motion to appoint a Vice Chair. Anne Byron moved to nominate Anne Hardy as Vice Chair. The motion was seconded by Chris Laux and the vote was in the affirmative with everyone voting in favor.
