Chairman Ivan Quinchia started the walk-thru at 2:01 p.m. He started the walk thru at the shed that has been constructed on the property. It was noted that Matthews wood business was located at the right of the roadway on to the property. Comments were that could be an issue if there were small kids in the campground and they wander over there. Also, the noise from the operation would be an issue.
