DECEMBER 29, 2021

2:30 P.M.      **SECOND PUBLIC HEARING – IN ACCORDANCE WITH RSA 41:14-a TO ACCEPT A PARCEL OF LAND:** Chair Moriarty opened the second public hearing held in accordance with RSA 41-14-a to accept a 15’x30’ parcel of land that was not transferred originally with the property where the Hebron Library sits. With not comments on the public hearing, Vice-Chair James moved to close the public hearing, seconded by Selectman Hazelton. The vote was unanimous.

- Chair Moriarty discussed with the Board the recent inquiry asked of the Highway Supervisor, Ben Hall, about the **town plowing the parking area for a non-profit organization**. The Board agreed that non-profits should hire private contractor’s for plowing their properties in Hebron.
- The Select Board signed the **2021 Tax Collector’s Refund** for Tax Map 18 Lot 023.
- The Select Board signed the **Bill of Sale** to John Dunklee for a generator transfer switch.
- The Select Board signed the **letter to NH Department of Transportation**, William Lambert, requesting the “Seasonal Speed Limit” of 40 mph for South Mayhew Turnpike from the Town of Bridgewater town line to 65 North Mayhew Turnpike.
- The Select Board signed **Yield Tax Warrant** and the **Certification of Yield Taxes Assessed**.
- The Select Board signed the **accounting manifest**.
- Ms. Sanborn reported to the Board that the **Town Office Building has heat again** and the all HVAC units were operational. The Board agreed to acknowledge people that helped get the replacement HVAC units. Chair Moriarty noted that the town should receive an “as built plan” for the final installation of the HVAC units with the new line sets.
