

TOWN OF HEBRON CONSERVATION COMMISSION

Notes made during a discussion with Mr. Charles Bean, October 23, 1970

1. NAME: The land which Mr. Bean is giving to the Town will be known as "The Charles Bean Conservation Area".
  
2. GENERAL PURPOSE: To preserve an area of great natural beauty for the benefit and enjoyment of the people of Hebron.
  
3. MANAGEMENT: The Hebron Conservation Commission will have the following responsibilities.
  - (a) To preserve for the foreseeable future the area's present natural beauty, free from roads, trails, swimming and camping areas, and all man-made structures.
  - (b) To maintain the area in such a way as to promote the conservation of wild life.
  
4. ADVISORY COMMITTEE: The Commission voted to create an Advisory Committee to assist it in the management of this area - and other areas for which it will be responsible in the future.

Charles Bean was elected Chairman of the Advisory Committee, with authority to appoint up to two additional members.
