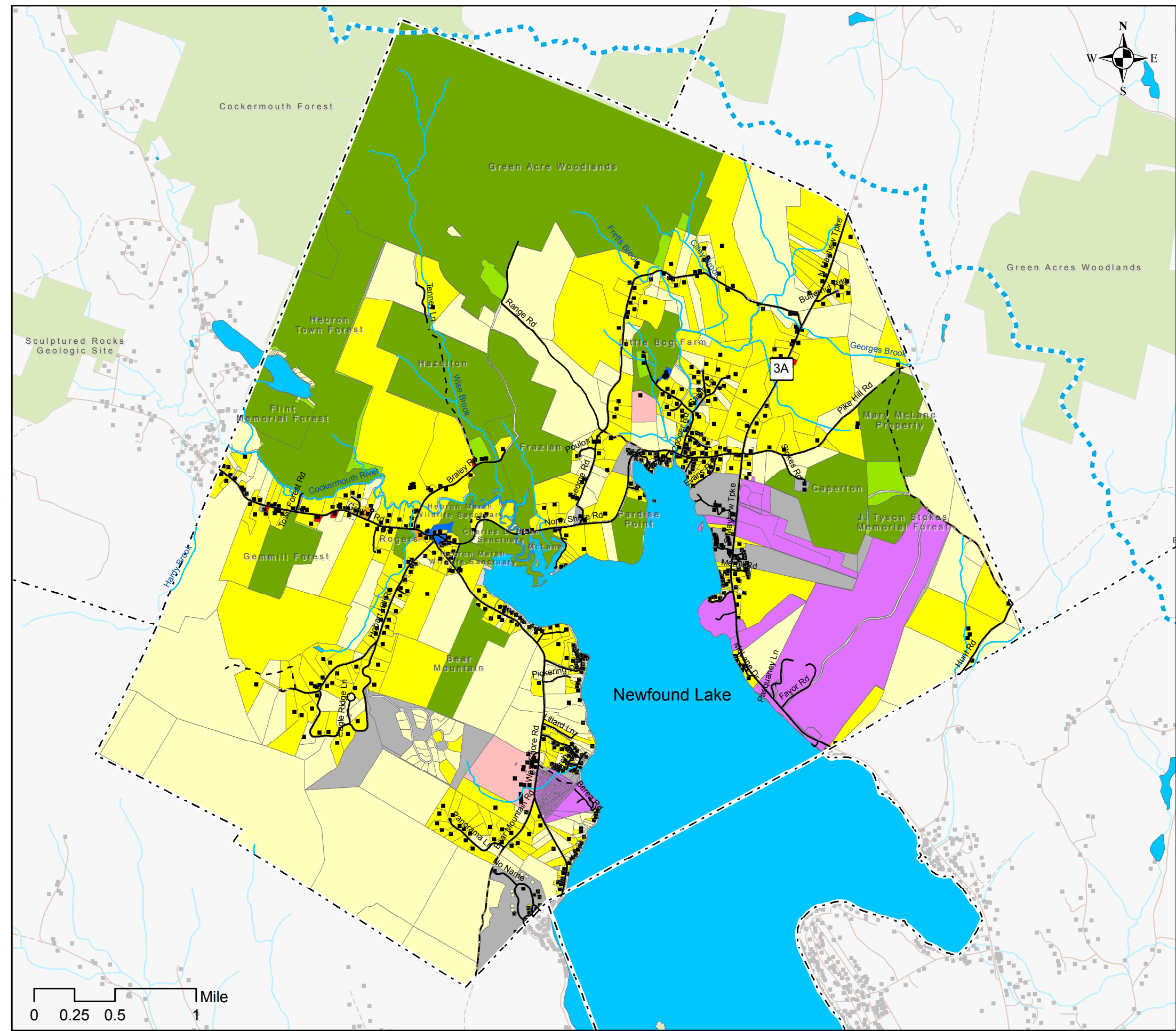


Existing Land Use

Existing Land Use

Land use types shown on this map are a "best estimate" based on Town tax assessor database records updated with known conserved lands, as well as extensive camp lands classified as Institutional land use in the map (Berea, Pasquaney, Onaway, Mowglis, and Wicosuta). It is likely that there are errors in this map due to incomplete assessor records which includes unclassified land uses on many lots and incorrect coding of unimproved residential lots.

Buildings were digitized from 2012 NHDOT aerial photography. Tree cover may have caused errors in mapping all buildings. Note that not all buildings are dwellings; some are outbuildings, barns and other non-residential structures.
